Bali Wedding Budget Planner & Worksheet

A simple, honest way to plan and track every cost of your Bali wedding — from venue and catering to styling, photography and the little extras.

There is no single price for a Bali wedding — your budget depends on guest count, venue, styling, food and beverage, photography, entertainment and your legal requirements. This worksheet helps you estimate each part, track what you actually spend, and stay in control. Work in whichever currency suits you, and treat the figures as a guide — for an accurate, itemised quote, just ask us.

WHAT SHAPES YOUR BUDGET

Six things drive almost every Bali wedding budget

- Guest count — the biggest lever; it drives catering, seating, venue size and styling.
- Venue — a private villa, beach club, clifftop or resort each sit at a different price point.
- Food & beverage — usually the largest single cost, priced per guest.
- Styling & flowers — from one ceremony setup to full installations.
- Photography & film — based on coverage and team, not guest numbers.
- Entertainment, legals & logistics — music, ceremony type, transport and coordination.

Catering & beverage	≈ 28%
Venue hire	≈ 15%
Styling & florals	≈ 12%
Photography & film	≈ 12%
Planning & coordination	≈ 10%
Entertainment & AV	≈ 8%
Beauty & attire	≈ 7%
Guest logistics	≈ 5%
Contingency & extras	≈ 3%

Six ways to lower your Bali wedding budget

- Trim the guest list — the single most effective saving; it lowers nearly every cost.
- Marry in shoulder season (Apr–May, Oct) for better value than peak months.
- Choose an inclusive venue that bundles more, so you bring in less.
- Style where it's seen — be generous on focal points, simple elsewhere.
- Prioritise one or two things you love and keep the rest elegant and simple.
- Use a local planner's pricing — relationships often beat tourist rates.
